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SURFACE PREPARATION

Previously Painted Surfaces with Pealing and Flaky paint with Rust:

1. Remove all paint back to bare surface in rusted areas. Treat as new work.

If in doubt to the correct surface preparation then contact Prominent Paints Technical Department first on 0861 776 646 or 011 389 4746.

LIMITATIONS:

- 1. Must be used only as a primer and not as a finishing coat.
- 2. If the Primer has not been applied within four hours after preparation, the preparation starts from scratch.
- 3. Exterior surfaces must not be exposed to rain within 12 hours of application.
- 4. Application conditions must be adhered to.
- 5. Prominent Paints Rust Primer cannot be over coated with Prominent Paints Machinery Enamel products and other strong solvent products e.g. Prominent Paints 2 Pack Polyurethane Floor Coating.
- 6. Product not UV resistant.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- 1. Keep out of reach of children.
- 2. Ensure to maintain good ventilation during application and drying process.
