PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

A pigmented, pure acrylic membrane-free waterproof coating with excellent UV resistance.

INTENDED USES:

- 1. For waterproofing of corrugated iron roofs, tile roofs and fibre cement roofs.
- 2. Parapet and horizontal walls and windowsills.

FEATURES:

APPLICATION DETAILS:

Mixing:	Stir well before use with flat paddle to an even consistency. Stir occasionally during use.
Method:	Brush only. Apply the second coat perpendicular to the first coat.
Thinning:	Not recommended.
Cleaning:	Water when wet, Lacquer thinners when dry.
Conditions:	Temperature between 5°C and 40°C. Relative humidity of less than 85%, preferably
	between 10:00 and 16:00 and if possible, away from direct sunlight.
Drying time:	24 hours – 48 hours depending on weather conditions at 23°C.
Recoating time:	24 hours at 23°C.
Requirements:	Two coats at 1 - 2m ² /Lt per coat. 2 nd coat need to be applied perpendicular to the 1 st coat.
	Or Multiple perpendicular coats can be applied to achieve a minimum of $1000\mu m$ DFT.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Surfaces must be sound, clean, and dry (moisture content below 15%) before painting. <u>New work:</u>

1. Rusted galvanised iron:	Loose rust and oxidation must be mechanically removed. Clean with Prominent General Purpose Cleaner at a diluted ratio of 1:10 with water and abrade before rinsing with clean water. Treat the surface with Prominent Multi Surface Etch Cleaner and abrasive pads to a water break-free surface allowing reaction time of 20 minutes. Rinse well with clean water and allow drying before coating with two or more coats of Prominent Rust Primer within four hours after surface is dry followed by
2. Galvanised iron:	 Prominent Fibre Seal for Waterproofing. Remove fabricators pre-treated oil and any other contamination with Prominent General Purpose Cleaner at a diluted ratio of 1:10 with water and abrade before rinsing with clean water. Treat the surface with Prominent Multi Surface Etch Cleaner and abrasive pads to a water break-free surface allowing reaction time of 20 minutes. Rinse well with clean water and allow drying before coating with two or more coats of Prominent Rust Primer within four hours after surface is dry followed by Prominent Fibre Seal for Waterproofing.
3. Cement:	Brush down with soft bristle broom. Apply one coat Prominent Dampcure or Select Plaster Primer.
4. Concrete:	Brush down with soft bristle broom. Apply one coat Prominent Dampcure or Select Plaster Primer.
5. Wood:	Sand smooth. Apply one coat Prominent Paints Wood Primer.
6. Mild steel:	Remove all rust mechanically, degrease with Prominent General Purpose Cleaner at a diluted ratio of 1:10 with water. Rinse with clean water or high-pressure water. Allow to dry. Apply 2 coats Prominent Paints Rust Primer.
Redecorating:	
1. Gloss paint:	Sand well to a matt finish clean and apply directly.
2. Emulsion paint in good conditions:	Clean well and apply directly.
3. Chalky surface:	Wire brush/high-pressure water jet and apply one coat Prominent Damp Cure or Prominent Surface Restorer.

4. Poor condition surface:



Strip down and treat as new surface.

LIMITATIONS:

- 1. Cannot be overcoated with non-flexible paints.
- 2. Not for sealing roof overlaps or joints.
- 3. Not suitable for fishponds.
- 4. Not suitable for concrete roofs where ponding will occur.
- 5. Prominent Paints Fibre Seal is not formulated for tinting.
- 6. Do not apply to surfaces where the temperature is less than 10°C.
- 7. Cannot be applied to wet or damp surfaces or in conditions other than specified, or if rainfall or dew is imminent.
