PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

A high hiding economical paint coating for interior and exterior use. Matt acrylic with low VOC level for walls and ceilings

INTENDED USES:

- 1. Correctly prepared and primed sound interior and exterior cement plaster and ceilings (Not recommended for scratch plaster, Tyrolean Plaster, Rhinolite and Gypsum plaster).
- 2. Sound previously painted surfaces.
- 3. Correctly prepared and primed gypsum plaster and ceiling boards.

Water-based Low odour.

Good over coating properties

Good obliteration

PRODUCT INFORMATION:

Appearance: Matt.

Colours: White. Tinting not recommended.

Solids: $\pm 50\%$ by mass and $\pm 22,5\%$ by volume.

Density: \pm 1,34kg/l. Recommended Wet Film Thickness: 180 μ m

Recommended Dry Film Thickness: 40µm per coat.

Spreading rate: 4 - 8m²/l dependent on surface porosity and texture.

Viscosity at 23°C: 110-120KU. Flashpoint: Non-flammable.

APPLICATION DETAILS:

Mixing: Stir well before use with a flat paddle to an even consistency. Stir occasionally during

use.

Method: Roller (medium, long woven pile or high loading long pile), brush and spray

application.

Thinning: Not recommended.

Cleaning: Remove as much of the product as possible from the application equipment before

cleaning it with water.

Application Conditions: <u>Surface Temperature</u> <u>Ambient Temperature</u> <u>Relative Humidity</u>

or 3°C above dew point, if possible, away from direct sunlight

Note: higher temperatures will accelerate the drying times (approximately halved for every 10°C increase) whilst lower temperatures will retard the drying times

(approximately doubled for every 10°C decrease).

Requirements: 2 coats minimum.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Surfaces must be sound, clean, and dry (moisture content below 15%) before painting. Newly applied plaster needs to be left for 21 to 28 days or 1 week for every 5mm thickness of plaster. Undesirable weather conditions e.g. cold or wet weather conditions will result in extended curing period.

Plaster sand to comply with SABS 1090 requirements. Plaster mix must have a minimum thickness of 10mm, free from soft and friable material and comply with SABS 0164-1 for strength (MPA).

New Work:

1. Interior cement plaster Prime using Prominent Damp Cure or Select Palster Primer and

apply two coats.

2. Exterior cement plaster Prime using Prominent Damp Cure or Select Palster Primer and

apply two coats.

3. Gypsum ceiling boards Prime using Prominent Damp Cure or Select Palster Primer and

apply two coats.

Rhinolited surfaces
 Prime with one coat of Prominent Paints Select Plaster Primer.
 Partitioning Board
 Prime with one coat of Prominent Paints Select Plaster Primer

Redecorating:

1. Sound condition Sand to matt finish, clean with Prominent General Purpose Cleaner

diluted 1:10 with water, allow drying and apply directly.

2. Powdered or Chalky

Clean the surface with high pressure water to remove chalkiness or sand with P80 sandpaper and clean with Prominent Congress Purpose

sand with P80 sandpaper and clean with Prominent General Purpose Cleaner diluted 1:10 with water and abrasive pad to remove chalkiness. Rinse with water. Allow drying before applying a coat of

Prominent Paints Select Bonding Liquid.

3. Blistering, loose & flaking paint Clean the surface with high pressure water and/or by scraping, wire

brush or sand with P80 sandpaper. Remove dust. Apply 1 coat Prominent Paints Select High Cover if the surface proves to be

sound.



4. Gloss & Semi-Gloss acrylic surfaces

Sand to a matt finish with fine sandpaper to provide a good key.

Remove dust and apply directly.

5. Gloss & Semi-Gloss enamel surfaces Sand to a matt finish with fine sandpaper to provide a good key. Remove dust and apply 1 coat of Prominent Select Universal

Undercoat.

6. Moisture infected walls Consult Prominent Paints Technical Department.

It is advisable to test the compatibility of Select High Cover on the prepared previously painted surfaces. Paint a small section and test the adhesion after 48 hours by applying a strip of masking tape and attempt to rip the paint off. If the adhesion result proves to be good, then proceed with painting.

LIMITATIONS:

- 1. Not to be used on rhinolite and fibre cement as a direct application.
- 2. Cannot be applied in cold or wet rainy conditions below 10°C.
- 3. Product cannot accommodate excessive movement, i.e. hairline cracking or application onto flexible coatings like textured coats and waterproofing systems.
- 4. Cannot be applied on a rough surface like Trowel-on or scratch plaster.
- 5. Not recommended for areas where good durability is required.
- 6. Prominent Paints Select High Cover is not designed for tinting.
- 7. Thinning of Prominent Paints Select High Cover will reduce the opacity.
- 8. Can only be applied under specified conditions.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- 1. Keep out of reach of children.
- 2. Ensure to maintain good ventilation during application and drying process.
- 3. In case of skin contact, wash with soap and water or a recognised skin cleaner. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact with eyes rinse immediately with running water and seek medical advice
- 4. If the product is ingested, drink plenty of water or milk. Do not induce vomiting at any time. Seek medical advice.
